

MTSE 2025 Frequently Asked Questions

1. Q: Who is eligible to participate in the Millat Talent Search Exam (MTSE) 2025?

A: MTSE 2025 is open to students who will be taking the Class 10th Exam in the academic year 2024-2025.

2. Q: What scholarship amount is offered to successful MTSE candidates?

A: MTSE provides scholarships by covering the course fees for two-year programs rather than a cash payment. The scholarship offers up to a 100% fee waiver for top rankers.

3. Q: What courses and programs are covered by the MTSE scholarship?

A: MTSE scholarships cover two-year programs for IIT-JEE, NEET, NDA, CA Foundation, CLAT, and UPSC preparation.

4. Q: How can I register for MTSE?

A: Register online by visiting the MTSE Registration Portal on www.mferd.org. Registration is open from October 26, 2024, until November 25, 2024.

5. Q: What is the syllabus for the MTSE exam?

A: The MTSE syllabus includes Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, English, Mental Ability, Deeniyat, and Social Science. For a detailed syllabus, visit this link.

6. Q: How are candidates selected for the scholarship and course benefits?

A: Selection is based on a written test and an oral exam for qualified candidates. The top performers will be eligible for scholarships and course benefits.

7. Q: What are the available courses and seats at MS Education Academy, Hyderabad?

A: MS Education Academy offers NEET and IIT preparation with 2 years of Intermediate study. There are 40 seats for each course, available for both residential and day scholars.

8. Q: What courses are available at Anees Defence Career Institute, Pune?

A: Anees Defence Career Institute provides NDA preparation along with 11th and 12th classes, with 40 seats available for day scholars only.

9. Q: What courses does The Hind Guru Academy in Delhi offer?

A: The Hind Guru Academy offers NEET, IIT-JEE, CLAT, CUET, and UPSC preparation. Total seats available are 40, with options for day scholars only.

10.Q: Can I choose to take the MTSE exam on more than one date?

A: No, MTSE 2025 will be conducted on December 1, 2024, only. There is no option to take the exam on multiple dates.

11.Q: Will the scholarship amount be paid in cash?

A: No, the scholarship amount is not paid in cash. Instead,

it covers the course and hostel fees for the selected programs.

12.Q: Can I change the course I have chosen in the application form after the exam or when the results are announced?

A: Yes, changes to your chosen course can be made at the time of joining.

13.Q: In which language will the question paper be provided?

A: The question paper will be in English only.

14.Q: What will be the medium of instruction once I am selected for the free course?

A: The medium of instruction for the courses offered through MTSE scholarships is English.

15.Q: If I don't qualify or am not selected in the final interview, can I still join the course?

A: Yes, you can still join the course by paying the fees. A nominal concession may be offered based on your exam and interview performance.

16.Q: What is NDA, and where is this course available?

A: NDA stands for the National Defence Academy. This program, along with 11th and 12th classes, is available at Anees Defence Career Institute, Pune. It is a day scholar program.

17.Q: Is the MTSE exam objective or subjective?

A: MTSE is an objective-type exam with multiple-choice

questions. Answers will be marked on an OMR sheet.

18.Q: Where can I download the hall ticket for the exam?

A: After successful registration, the hall ticket can be downloaded from the MTSE portal where you registered.

19.Q: What should I do if I forgot my application reference number?

A: The reference number is sent to your registered email. Alternatively, you can use your registered mobile number to download your hall ticket.

20.Q: Is there a fee for the MTSE exam registration, and do I need to pay anything at the exam centre?

A: The registration fee is ₹100, which is paid online during registration. There is no additional fee required at the exam center.
