



Frequently Asked Questions

1Q: Who is eligible to participate in the Millat Talent Search Exam (MTSE)?

A: MTSE is open to students who will be taking the Class 10th Exam in the academic year 2023-2024 and those preparing for the PUC 2nd year exam.

2Q: What is the scholarship amount offered to successful MTSE candidates?

A: Successful candidates can receive a scholarship worth Rs. 5 lakh per head. However, it's important to note that the scholarship amount will not be paid in cash. Instead, it will be provided in the form of covering the course fees for a two-year residential program.

3Q: What courses and programs are covered by the MTSE scholarship?

A: MTSE offers a two-year free coaching program for IIT-JEE, NEET, CA Foundation, CLAT, NDA, and the 10+2 program.

4Q: How can I register for MTSE?

A: Registration can be done online by visiting the MTSE Registration Portal at <https://mtse.gleamappstore.com/>. The registration period for the December 24, 2023 exam is until December 20, 2023, and for the January 7, 2024 exam, it is until January 3, 2024.

5Q: What is the syllabus for the MTSE exam?

A: The MTSE syllabus covers Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, English, Mental Ability, Deeniyat, and Social Science. Detailed syllabus information can be found [here](#).



6Q: How are candidates selected for the scholarship and course benefits?

A: The selection process includes a combination of a written test and an oral exam. Students who qualify will be eligible for the scholarship and course benefits.

7Q: What are the available courses and seats at MS Education Academy, Hyderabad?

A: MS Education Academy offers courses in NEET, IIT, CLAT & CA Foundation with 2 years Intermediate. There are 40 seats available for each course, and both residential and day scholar options are available.

8Q: What courses are offered at Millat Scholars Academy, Bangalore?

A: Millat Scholars Academy offers courses in NEET, JEE, CA Foundation with 2 years PUC, and CA Foundation with B.Com. There are 40 seats available for each course, and both residential and day scholar options are available.

9Q: What courses are available at Anees Defence Career Institute, Pune?

A: Anees Defence Career Institute offers a course in NDA with 11th and 12th. There are 40 seats available, and day scholar options are provided.

10Q: Can I choose to take the MTSE exam on both dates?

A: No, you are allowed to select and write the exam on either one of the two dates: 24th December 2023 or 7th January 2024. Taking the exam on both dates is not permitted.

11Q: Will the scholarship amount of Rs. 5 lakh be paid in cash?

A: No, the scholarship amount will not be paid in cash. Instead, it will be provided in the form of covering course fees and hostel fees for the selected programs.



12Q: Can I change the course I have opted for in the application form after the exam or when the result is announced?

A: Yes, you can make changes to your chosen course at the time of joining the course.

13Q: In which language will the question paper be?

A: The question paper will be in English only.

14Q: What will be the medium of instruction once I get selected for the free course?

A: The medium of instruction for the free course will be English.

15Q: If I don't qualify or am not selected in the final interview, is there still a chance for me to join the course?

A: Yes, you can still join the course, but you will need to pay the fee. A nominal concession may be provided based on your performance in the written exam and interview.

16Q: What is NDA, and where is this course available?

A: NDA stands for the National Defence Academy and Naval Academy Examination. This course is available at Anees Defence Career Institute, Pune, along with 11th and 12th classes. It is a day scholar program. If you prefer a residential program, you will need to pay the additional hostel fee.

17Q: Is MTSE a subjective exam or an objective type?

A: MTSE is an objective type exam. It consists of multiple-choice questions, and you are required to answer them on an OMR sheet. You can find the model paper on our webpage.



18Q: Where can I get the hall ticket for the exam?

A: After successfully completing the registration, you can download the hall ticket from the MTSE web portal where you registered. Look for the hall ticket download tab, located at the top of the application form.

19Q: I forgot to note my application reference number. How can I download the hall ticket?

A: The application reference number is sent to your registered email after successful completion of registration. Alternatively, you can download your hall ticket using your registered mobile number.

20Q: Is there any fee for the enrollment of the exam, or do I have to pay any fee at the exam center?

A: No, there is no fee for enrollment, and you do not have to pay anything to anyone for the MTSE exam.
